Re: Cease & Desist -False & Misleading Communications Regarding the Colorado Women's Alliance

Dear Ms. Wells:

As counsel for the Colorado Women's Alliance, I am writing to demand that the Colorado Accountable Government Alliance Independent Expenditure Committee ("CAGA") cease and desist from distributing any false or misleading communications regarding the Colorado Women's Alliance. Such communications include, but are not limited to, any electronic communications (email, Facebook posts, Twitter posts, or other similar means of communication), mailings, radio, television, robo-calls, or door-to-door communications.

CAGA's characterization of the Colorado Women's Alliance as a "radical anti-birth control front group" and CAGA's claim that the Colorado Women's Alliance "wants to outlaw common forms of birth control" (see attached Exhibit A) are baseless and without merit.

The Colorado Women's Alliance has never issued any statement opposing any woman's personal choice to use birth control. The Colorado Women's Alliance also has never sought to outlaw any common form of birth control. Any statements by CAGA to the contrary are both patently false and misleading.

Such false statements threaten the reputation and brand of the Colorado Women's Alliance and lead to irreparable damages caused by CAGA. Any further communications made by CAGA using either these or similar statements will be considered willful and reckless attempts to harm the brand and reputation of the Colorado Women's Alliance, interfere with organization's ability to operate, and an intentional attempt to cause economic damage to the Colorado Women's Alliance. Consequently, if CAGA persists in making such false or misleading statements, the Colorado Women's Alliance will seek any legal relief available to the organization.

The Colorado Women's Alliance is focused on discussing issues of importance to women in a substantive and meaningful way. Colorado Women's Alliance emphasizes that women, and the choices they make in their personal lives, are most directly affected by the strength of the economy, the availability of jobs, and the ability of women to secure financial security for themselves and their

families. Colorado Women's Alliance promotes public policies it believes will most directly and positively affect those issues. It is the position of the Colorado Women's Alliance that addressing economic issues most directly impacts the ability of women to make their own personal choices free from government or outside intrusion.


